**Brief Description of Organization:**

NRSP-Institute of Rural Management (N-IRM) is the largest capacity development and learning facility in the not-for-profit sector in Pakistan, conducting up to 600 different types of training with a turnout of around 60,000 trainees annually. Over the last 18 years, N-IRM has been directly responsible for building the capacity of development professionals and communities across Pakistan, as well as working with most UN agencies, World Bank, ADB, USAID, DFID, Norwegian and Federal and provincial governments.

**Information specific to the internship:**

**Primary Responsibilities**

The summer interns are asked to identify a research topic and submit the research proposal in the first week. After proposal approval, interns are asked to complete that assignment in the given timeframe. Projects assigned are interdisciplinary and involve extensive research combined with field exposure. Student interns will work with different sections of the organization including HRD, Monitoring & Evaluation, Social Mobilization, Community Development, Social Sector Services, Community Management, and Vocational Training.

Assignment Details:

1. Present a written research report at the end of their internship activity
2. Complete a program evaluation
3. Defend research at the final presentation/seminar
