**Brief Description of Organization:**

Mission Apollo is an organization that caters to the educational uplifting of India. Its aim is to bring high quality education to all strata of Indian society, particularly in the realms of leadership, scientific creativity, technological innovation, and confidence.

The organization runs after-school programs and workshops that are designed for students from the first to tenth classes. These camps are implemented both in schools and in Mission Apollo's centers, and are typically run by trainers at the undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate levels of education. In the past, Mission Apollo has run its camps in Pune, Nasik, and Mumbai in Maharashtra, as well as in Indore in Madhya Pradesh. ***Qualifications***

The Graduate Fellow should be an undergraduate or graduate student in the field of science or engineering.

***Primary Responsibilities***

The Graduate Fellow will be responsible for working as a trainer/"mad scientist" and for running programs in schools. In addition, the Fellow will be involved in developing curriculum for schools as per the requirements of various education boards in India.

**Schedule:**

Summer internship opportunity of up to 8 weeks in duration.

**Stipend/Assistance:**

Mission Apollo will offer a total stipend of Rs. 4,000 to help offset living expenses in Pune, Maharashtra. In addition, Mission Apollo is able to provide assistance in the accommodations search process, as well as support in arranging cultural excursions and language training.

**Additional Information:** The Graduate Fellow will be exposed to two regional languages – Hindi and Marathi. (S)he will be working as part of an organization that will provide language assistance as needed.
