Brief Description of Organization:

Teach For Pakistan, an initiative of the AMAN Foundation, is a social enterprise with the mission to create a nationwide movement of recent college graduates and young professionals who commit two years to teach in under-resourced schools and go on to become lifelong leaders working from across all fields to expand educational opportunities for all children. In two years, Teach For Pakistan has recruited, trained and placed 60 Fellows in 29 high-need schools in Karachi and Lahore, and continues to support their development as effective teachers and exceptional leaders. Teach For Pakistan is a partner in the Teach For All global network of similar social enterprises that includes Teach For America, UK's Teach First, and partners in 27 countries around the world.

Information Specific to Alumni Impact Research Internship:

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will demonstrate strong research and writing abilities. Successful candidates will also demonstrate:

- Strong time management , organizational and written communication skills
- Ability to take direction, work independently, and ask questions
- Attention to detail

Primary Responsibilities:

Support Teach For Pakistan's collaboration with external partners by developing a database of key institutions within and outside education in Pakistan (primary and secondary research required)

- Conduct primary and secondary research to identify career pathways within key sectors through which alumni can have maximum impact on education
- Be part of the functional team and participate in meetings

The Alumni Impact team at Teach For Pakistan is responsible for supporting the leadership and professional development of Fellows throughout the two year assignment and ensures that they receive the training to build the knowledge, skills and mindsets necessary for them to be effective alumni, working towards educational reform regardless of the career path they choose.

Information Specific to Training & Support, Summer Institute Intern

Qualifications:

Candidates must demonstrate initiative, commitment to social change and strong multi-tasking and inter-personal skills. Successful candidates will also demonstrate:

- Ability to learn quickly, thrive in a fast paced environment and prioritize effectively
- Extraordinary attention to detail, organizational and time-managements skills
- Ability to take direction, work independently and in teams, and ask questions

Responsibilities:

Teach For Pakistan conducts a six-week, pre-placement summer training institute inducting the new cohort of Fellows prior to placement in schools. This position is part of the Training & Support team. The Training & Support Unit is responsible for developing and managing systems for supporting Teach For Pakistan Fellows to perform as effective teachers in the classroom and in the wider school environment.

- Be part of the Teach For Pakistan Training team to execute our third Summer Institute for the 2013 cohort of Fellows
- Serve as a liaison between Teach For Pakistan and summer school placement sites
- Support documentation and videography during training sessions
- Support training institute team needs as necessary
- Be part of the functional team and participate in meetings
- Support the execution of the training institute, which includes, but is not limited to completing operational tasks to support program goals
- Research national and international curricula to deepen understanding of ideal student learning outcomes
- Support the development of a literacy curriculum and toolkit for both primary and secondary school teachers
- Be part of the functional team and participate in meetings
- Present research report to Senior Management team at Teach For Pakistan and Aman Foundation

This position is especially suited to candidates who are interested in education policy including teacher recruitment and selection. Students of the John F. Kennedy School of Government and/or Graduate School of Education preferred, Strong time management and organizational skills, Ability to take direction, work independently, and ask questions, Attention to detail

Responsibilities:

The Recruitment and Selection team is responsible for all activities pertaining to the identification, recruitment and selection of graduates and young professionals who have the potential to be highly effective teachers and leaders to enlist them in the movement against educational inequity in Pakistan.

Information Specific to Training and Support, Placement Schools Research Intern

Qualifications:

Ideal candidates must possess the ability to work independently. They must have strong written, oral communication and inter-personal skills. This position is especially suited to candidates who are interested in education policy, school governance and high-impact interventions. Successful candidates will also demonstrate:

- Students of the John F. Kennedy School of Government and/or Graduate School of Education preferred
- Strong time management and organizational skills
- Ability to take direction and ask clarifying questions
- Attention to detail

Responsibilities

The Training & Support Unit is responsible for developing and managing systems for supporting Teach For Pakistan Fellows to perform as effective teachers in the classroom and in the wider school environment.

- Support the refinement of Teach For Pakistan's existing placement school selection criteria including peri-urban and semi-urban settings as we expand nationwide (primary and secondary research)
- Be part of the functional team and participate in weekly meetings
- Share updates with the senior management team

Stipend/Assistance:

Teach for Pakistan provides a general stipend of Rs. 5,000.
